LETTER TURNOVER

The more letters you play on each move:

- the more letters you take from the bag;
- the greater will be your share of the 100 tiles;
- the greater will be your chance of picking high-value letters, blanks and S's.

RACK BALANCE

- ★ try and keep a balanced rack, that is,
2 OR 3 VOWELS/4 OR 5 CONSONANTS
- ★ if you have all vowels or all consonants, then retain a couple and use a turn to exchange, or exchange the lot!
- ★ If you have letter duplicates or triplicates, then play to remove excess.

GOOD COMBINATIONS

Shuffle your tiles to make familiar word beginnings or endings of 2, 3 or 4 letters and place them to the left or right of your rack. This will help you spot All Outs.
