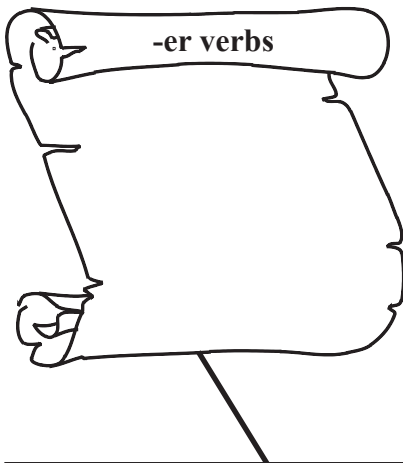


VERBS 4 : FUTURE TENSE

The **future** tense tells us about something that will happen in the future, eg. **I will go**.

To form the future tense:

Take the infinitive and add the future tense endings.

With “-re” verbs you **MUST** remove the “e” before adding the endings.

Use pages 305-309 of your *Chambers Harrap's French School Dictionary (The Future Tense)* to work out the future tense endings.

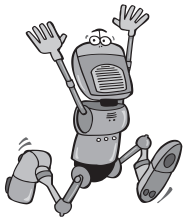
