

Conditionals express the possibility of an action, or an imaginary situation. A conditional uses the forms **would**, **could**, **might** or **may** in front of the verb.

I *would like* a cup of cocoa.

I *could come* tomorrow.

We *might go* to the park if the sun comes out.

Sometimes the word **of** is used mistakenly instead of the word **have** in conditionals, and you should be careful not to do this:

- ✘ I *would of gone*, but I was too busy.
- ✓ I *would have gone*, but I was too busy.
